



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#### Tip 1: Study Screenwriting!

- Thrillers = genre of the 2020s
- Audiences love it in movies & TV
- Adaptations are hot right now
- 'Screenwriting is structure'
- Screenwriting = plot-led
- Crime stories = plot-led
- Stand out with meaty plots!
- (All these tips work for scripts too)



#### **Tip 2: All About Premises**

- Intrigue is everything
- Mystery is important
- Don't forget <u>The Hook</u>
- Commercial hook = desire-led
- Dramatic hook = asks audience to put themselves in protagonist's place
- "What would <u>YOU</u> do?"

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#### Tip 3: Create A Compelling Protagonist

- Flawed and damaged
- Female leads feature in this genre
- Issues with men, children, home
- Can't go to police for some reason
- Likeability don't worry about this
- Believability rich history of crime!
- Authenticity research is key

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#### Tip 4: Protagonist's Mission

- What does the protagonist want?
- Why can't the police handle it?
- What is the antagonist's 'evil plan'?
- What is the crime?
- Why does the antagonist do it?
- Cover-ups & conspiracy
- Abduction & hostage-taking
- Stalking & poison pen letters

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#### Tip 5: Secondary Characters

- Relatability is key here
- Their job = HELP or HINDER
- Protagonist in his/her mission
- Diversity key in 2020s
- LGBTQ, BIPOC, Disabled
- Research tropes
- Tropedia
- TVTropes.org

- TIP 6: Build suspense SLOWLY (don't rush)
- Study visual representations of structure

- TIP 7: Don't forget your setting!
- Storyworld as character in own right
- Mine? Seaside towns out of season

- Plot backwards to 'find' the beginning
