	DC	Okay that right continues throughout this interview, so at any point you think to yourself oh I would like a further chat with my Solicitor it's absolutely fine, let me know I'll turn the CDs off and you can have that chat in private.
	SUS	Okay.
		You can do that as many times as you like, and you are not judged on it because that's your right.
	SUS	Okay.
	DC	Okay? You were arrested and cautioned earlier today for... a robbery and attempted robbery, you are still under caution I need to remind you of that caution it's important that you understand it all right. You do not have to say anything, but it may harm your defence if you do not mention when questioned something which you later rely on in Court, anything you do say it may be given in evidence. Do you understand the caution?
	SUS	Yeah.
	DC	Okay I explain it for everyone all right so I'm just gonna go through it because as I say it is important that you fully understand it.... You have a right to silence it means you don't have to answer my questions now that's your right. However, if this matter was to end up at Court at a later date, and at Court you do answer those questions or similar questions or you give an account at Court that you [inaudible] during this interview, and you wish to use that information as a defence... the Court can draw their own conclusions as to why you haven't told me now because this is your chance to do so, and they may feel well he's had time to leave the Police Station think up a story and the story actually given at Court is false.

It reads as follows: I () date of birth 21.2. () ... has been arrested in connection with a robbery and an attempted robbery on the 10th and the 9th of January respectively.... I know nothing about any robbery or attempted robbery in Markfield Park over the weekend. On Saturday the 10th of January in the early evening I purchased a mobile phone on West Green Road... I put my SIM card in the phone.... Police came to my house and at that point I suspected that the phone might have been stolen... there was no other reason for the Police to attend my house.... I threw the phone away because I panicked. That as I said signed by Mr () and dated today's date and I'm handing it to the Officer now.
