What is a Query Letter?

A query letter is a formal letter sent by a writer to <u>magazine</u> editors, <u>literary</u> <u>agents</u> and sometimes <u>publishing houses</u> or companies, to propose writing ideas.

For example, a standard requested format for a manuscript query letter to a literary agent could be approximately 200-400 words, expressing the following information: The topic of the work, The target audience, A short description of the plot and A short bio of the author

The literary agent would then decide whether to contact the author and request to see the manuscript, based on the contents of the query letter. In this sense, the guery letter is an author's first step toward getting their manuscript published.



Query Letter Writing

Introduction

Include relevant metadata including, title, word count, comparative titles, media mashups and personalisation.

Addressed to

Research the agent the letter is addressed to. Know their name and spell correctly. Avoid common errors like typos.

Pitch

Keep sentences and paragraphs concise. Avoid jargon and unnecessary complexity.



Bio

Use friendly, formal and direct language. Include only relevant information regarding writing experience or accolades.

Introduction

Must include the following:

- Agent's Full Name (Personalisation)
- Title of the Novel
- Word count of the Novel (Ya=<100k, Adult =<150k)
- Genre (Fantasy, Science Fiction, Speculative, Horror)
- Target Audience (Kidlit, YA, Adult)

This is a media mashup or "sticky mashup." Not comps. This is a great way to pitch a book "this meets that. (Media mashups can be books, films, games etc).

Comps are books that have been published in the past 2-3 years that would fit on the same bookshelf as your story. For example, this story would fit next to xxx and xxx

• Note: COMP TITLES should be in CAPS • Also note that your COMPS can't be too successful. You can't compare to books like Harry Potter or Divergent. The key is a recent book with relatively good

Pitch

PITCH (PARAGRAPH ONE/INTRO): Lóre has fiery blades and ice in her veins. One of these is a secret that will get her killed. In the land of Oru, everyone is born with agbára—the ability to summon energy from the sun. Everyone that is, except Lóre. She keeps this secret close to her heart, knowing her mother was killed for the same reason.

PITCH (PARAGRAPH TWO/MIDDLE): When the gods declare Lóre's best friend, Alawani, an Agurram—a priest of the holy order. He will be stripped of his agbára in a trial that has never yielded more than two survivors each time the gods call. Unwilling to risk his life for the gods that cursed her, Lóre breaks into the temple. In a desperate act to channel agbára and save him, something else comes forth from her hands—a destructive shadow magic that draws on the energy of everyone and everything around her.

PITCH (PARAGRAPH THREE/ENDING): She and Alawani escape, but not before she catches the attention of the Holy Order. While on the run, Lóre discovers her true identity and learns that Alawani's grandfather, the Holy Order's leader, murdered her mother. He will stop at nothing to ensure that Lóre is the last of her kind. Lóre finds herself choosing between Alawani and the magic within her.

Pitch Questions

Ql: Who is your primary character? Q2: What does your character want at the beginning that they don't have? Q3: What is keeping them from getting it? Q4: What's at stake if they don't get it? Q5: What is the inciting incident in your book? Q6: Is there a shocking twist? Q7: What's the setting?

Biography

BIO: I am a Yoruba woman, and stories are the foundation of my culture. In this book are many tales of old as told by my grandmother. FIRSTBORN OF THE SUN is a potential series with multiple third-person limited POVs. This manuscript was shortlisted for the 2022 Jericho Writers Friday Night Live Competition and the 2022 Kit De Waal Bursary, was longlisted for the 2023 REVPIT competition and won the 2023 Jericho Writers' Self Edit Course Bursary. Five agents have requested this manuscript in full.

Query Letter Do's



Do Your Research

Research, brainstorm, and streamline your list of agents before submitting. Follow their guidelines.

Feedback & Revision


Review your draft for clarity, coherence, and conciseness. (Use editors or beta readers)



Keep it succinct. Don't ramble. Don't sound apologetic, and don't sound arrogant. Keep the focus on your story, not yourself.



Correct grammar, spelling, and punctuation errors, and refine your writing for a polished final version.





Query Letter Dont's

DON'T BE NEGATIVE

If you don't believe in yourself and your work, no one else will. Don't be overly apologetic in your language.

DON'T OVERLOAD


Don't give personal information that is sensitive or unnecessary.

DON'T LOSE THE PITCH

Don't go into too much detail in your hook. Fewer than 400 words is best. Don't reveal the end of your book in the query letter.

DON'T IGNORE THE RULES

If an agent is closed to queries, respect that. Don't be rude when you get rejections. Don't send to agents who don't represent your genre



SUMMARY: Sample Query Letter

- Query letters follow a specific format and should ideally include:
 - The title of your book
 - A short one or two-line pitch
 - The genre and word count
- A comparative book example or two (this helps the agent with market
 - positioning)
 - An outline of your plot
 - Some info about the main character and their motivation
- Some information about you (past writing experience, accolades, why you
 - wrote this story)
 - Your contact details




