What happens during the editing process




Editing is where your story comes to life.

During the editing process, you will examine every aspect of your story: your plot, characters, settings, word choice, structure, and more.

Many writers dread the editing process because they're not sure what to expect. Let's look at a linear editing journey.











What makes a good editing process is up to you.

Some writers prefer to work by themselves the entire time. Some writers like to work with other people the entire time. Some like to use technology, some do not. Some will go through one round of revisions, some will go through dozens.

That's all okay!









Why technology is helpful for editing



Technology can help save time and money when editing.

Editing is challenging. It's hard and expensive to find resources. Technology can help:

- Provide instant feedback
- Polish before you use a human editor
- Share difficult-to-find information






Using technology to support story editing






What Happens During Story Editing:

- Evaluate your manuscript and the story you're telling
- Substantive look at the structure and development of your story or argument



Setting:

- Your characters will grow out of the world you create.
- Does your setting have not only an engaging location, but use of time, date, objects, and senses?



Characters:

- Your characters are what your audience will relate to.
- Do your characters have clear goals and a recognizable point-of-view?



Scene:

- Your scenes must progress at an effective and engaging pace.
- Do you have effective arcs in each scene?

Technology can support with story editing


Using technology to support line editing





What Happens During Line Editing:

- When you look at the use of language to tell a clear and engaging story
- Assess word choice, readability, style
- Overall goal of clarity



Clarity:

- Are your subjects and verbs the stars of your sentences?
- Is your writing readable for your audience?
- Are you choosing specific words that explain exactly what you're trying to say?





Engagement:


- Have you kept up the pacing?
- Have you eliminated echoes and repeats?
- Have you used enough sensory words?
